Course Description	<p>The short course prepares students in the use of electronic navigation and position fixing equipment found onboard a modern vessel.</p> <p>The course is a statutory requirement under the SAMSA Code for candidates of Port Operations Certificates of Competency. In addition holders of a Deck Officer Certificate of Competency who have taken up careers ashore and wish to keep their CoC valid are required to complete the course for re-validation purposes. Re-validation of certificates of competency is every five years. The course is presently being offered by the South African Maritime Training Academy (SAMTRA), CPUT's Department of Maritime Studies and Project Maritime. These providers are all located in the Western Cape, with no providers on the eastern seaboard of South Africa.</p>
