

Course Title	HIV Symptom Management for Health Care Professionals
Course Description	The National Strategic Plan on HIV, STI's and TB has as Strategic Objective 3: Sustaining Health and Wellness. The primary focus of strategic objective 3 is to achieve significant reduction in deaths and disability as a result of HIV and TB. It is envisaged that this will be achieved through universal access to affordable and good quality diagnosis, treatment and care (SANAC, 2011). The South African Nursing Council has determined that all nurses must be trained in HIV/AIDS Management. There are very few such courses in Durban and we receive a great number of requests for such training. In addition we are compelled to provide such a module within our programmes, and it makes sense to allow informal students to attend the module and in so doing meet a need and generate income for the department. The course is strategic as many of the nurses who complete the short courses have come back and registered for other formal programmes in nursing. It is also marketable and sustainable.
